STUDENT'S AGREEMENT WITH DON BOSCO TECHNICAL COLLEGE-CEBU, INC.

I hereby pledge to live the ideals of a true Bosconian, abide by the following disciplinary norms hereunder stated as fundamental guidelines for the attainment of a sound Christian education.

As a student

1. I fully accept the school rules and other directives set by school authorities, knowing that the said rules and directives are for my own good.
2. Having enrolled in **Don Bosco Technical College – Cebu, Inc.**, Cebu City, I shall uphold the rules and guidelines of the school within and outside the campus.
3. I shall cooperate to the best of my ability to attain the aim of the school, which is to form in me a practicing Catholic and a concerned Filipino citizen.
4. I recognize my commitment to observe the school requirements included among others:
 - a. *Punctuality in reporting for school and class activities, bringing the school diary, the prayer book, and the required class materials;*
 - b. *Wearing of the prescribed uniform at all times (prescribed t-shirt, pants, ID with sling, shoes);*
 - c. *Observe a Bosconian grooming with the prescribed haircut, ears with no piercing and earrings, and a body without tattoos;*
 - d. *At all times maintain a gentlemanly behavior towards fellow Bosconians by avoiding any semblance of bullying or the other extreme of effeminate gestures in words and action;*
 - e. *Submit the important school requirements namely: authenticated PSA birth certificate, report card, correction of name, permanent record (Form 137/SF10), and other enrollment documents.*
5. In case of my failure to comply with this Agreement (which is part of the condition of my acceptance) through my neglect, I shall respect the right of the school to drop my name from the rolls
6. I acknowledge that the acts considered as serious offenses in the Student's Guidelines after due investigation, can disqualify me from continuing my studies in Don Bosco Technical College – Cebu, Inc., according to the gravity of the offense without prejudice to the imposition of heavier penalties as provided for by the DepEd and by the Manual of Regulations for Private Schools (MRPS).
7. I accept the right of the school to refuse my admission for the next school year if in case of my non-fulfillment of any of the foregoing conditions.

PARENTS' AGREEMENT WITH DON BOSCO TECHNICAL COLLEGE – CEBU, INC.

We, parents of _____ do hereby recognize that by enrolling our son/daughter in Don Bosco Technical College – Cebu, Inc., contract an agreement with the school, fully believing in its capacity to provide a high standard of Catholic education.

This agreement entails that:

Don Bosco Technical College – Cebu, Inc., undertakes the responsibility to teach our son/daughter according to the rules and regulations for private schools promulgated by the DepEd, and that we, parents abide by the rules and policies of the said school in everything that pertains to school matters, especially with regards to school requirements, fees and activities.

In particular, we hereby agree to the following terms and conditions, without any doubt or mental reservation:

1. We are enrolling our child for one year or 10 months from **June to March**. In case we withdraw our child after two weeks of classes, we agree to pay the full fees of one school year (Art. XIII Sec. 66 MRPS).
2. We agree to promptly pay the school fees.
3. We agree with the school's mission statement and philosophy of education as stated in the Students' Guidelines;
4. We fully support the school, its administration and faculty, in implementing its programs, and refrain from any action whatsoever that will directly work against the interest of the school, its administration and faculty, and destroy its good name in the community.
5. We accept the rights and prerogatives of the school to set norms and policies, requirements and fees, subject only to the rules and regulations set by the DepEd.
6. We shall attend the Parents' Assembly if required by the Principal as well as other meetings called by the school in order to share our views and sentiments towards a better implementation of the school's objectives.
7. We shall support our son's/daughter's co-curricular activities in school undertaken with our permission;
8. We recognize the Parents' Assembly as the final forum for setting disputes that arise regarding school affairs not covered by the rules and policies of the school, without prejudice to our right to consult the matter to the DepEd for enlightenment;
9. We retain our rights to complain and air grievances only during the Parents' Assembly and not in any other form, without any way harming the name of the school, its administration and faculty, nor disrupting or hampering school activities through pickets or demonstrations.

"We fully accept the right of the school to refuse admission to our son/daughter at any time of the school year or to refuse promotion or graduation or participation in graduation if we fail to comply with or abide by any of the above written terms and conditions of this Agreement and those mentioned in our son's Student's Guidelines and Agreement, or when our son/daughter fails to comply with or abide by any of the terms and conditions of the said Student Guidelines and Agreement, most especially in the exercise of the right and or prerogative of the school to hold my son/daughter under probation, to exclude or expel him, to allow him/her to graduate without march, to graduate him/her in summer (which is without march), to fail out, to drop from its rolls, to pass out, or to place my son/daughter under summer remedial due to any cause stated therein."

We have carefully read, understood and agree to the duties and obligations as outlined above.
